Additionally, there are many accounts that need bringing up to date, that are currently in arrears, it takes a lot of time and effort to chase debts, time which we would be better investing into our nursery. Please can we remind families to label all your child's personal items, such as coats, jackets, shoes, comforters, and dummies. It is hard to keep track of every child's item and being labelled helps us so much.
